The mission of Destiny, Power & Purpose, Inc. (DPP) is to help individuals to break the vicious cycle of repeated drug addiction and incarceration off their lives through empowerment.

Destiny, Power & Purpose, Inc. (DPP) is a nonprofit 501c3 Human Services Provider focused on providing high-quality recovery & reentry support services; and a continuum of care to individuals that find it difficult to make a change in habits and behaviors that continuously lead to the use of drugs, alcohol and/or incarceration.

In 2012, DPP was selected as the Maryland RecoveryNet (MDRN) Care Coordination provider for Prince Georges County. In 2013, DPP received the contract to provide State Care Coordination services through the Prince Georges County Health Department. Since January 2012, DPP has provided care coordination and recovery support services to over 3500 Prince Georges County residents receiving residential, outpatient, jail-based treatment and rehabilitation services.

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CARE COORDINATION

What is State Care Coordination?

State Care Coordination (SCC) are case management & recovery support services provided through DPP and funded by the Prince George's County Department of Health.

The purpose for SCC is to improve recovery outcomes for individuals identified as high risk for relapse; and to insure that recognized obstacles to recovery are minimized. Obstacles can include unstable housing, lack of transportation; as well mental health, health, family, unemployment, and educational issues, etc.

SCC services are designed to provide recovery support & assistance to individuals engaged in state-funded treatment programs; by navigating them through the recovery process; as well as provide referrals and linkages to county, community, faith based and other human services organizations.

SCC services overall goal is to encourage better recovery outcomes and to create a greater opportunity for a client to be successful on their self-identified journey in recovery!!

Who is eligible for SCC services?

The Prince George's County Department of Health has authorized that all Prince George's County residents that are receiving residential, intensive outpatient/ outpatient or jail-based treatment services in the state of Maryland be mandated recipients of SCC services.

The individual must be:

- ***An adult who is 18 years or older***
- ***Currently enrolled and actively participating in an inpatient, outpatient or rehabilitation program; or participating in any recovery program or activities.***

HOW TO ENROLL IN SCC

The Counselor/Case Manager at the facility will provide a SCC referral to DPP, the Prince Georges County Care Coordination Provider. DPP will meet with the client; assess the clients need; and then determine ongoing clinical and recovery support needs during an initial intake and enrollment process. In addition to SCC services, it will be determined whether the client is an eligible recipient for additional recovery support via the [Maryland RecoveryNet Program](#).

RECOVERY SUPPORT

Maryland RecoveryNet Services

Maryland RecoveryNet is a state funded program that provides access to additional recovery support services to the client while in their recovery.

Additional Recovery Support Services may include:

- ◆ Recovery Housing
- ◆ Transportation
- ◆ Vital Documents (Identification, Birth Certificate, etc.)
- ◆ Gap Services (limited assistance with food, toiletries, clothing, medical co-pays, job & educational needs, medications, etc.)
